Solid organ transplant is lifesaving surgery for individuals with failure of a vital body organ. For patients with kidney failure requiring dialysis, the gift of a kidney from a family member brings greater health and freedom from dialysis. In 1998, our practice, along with Tower Surgical, performed the first laparoscopic living-related kidney donation in the State of Indiana.

In conjunction with the Methodist Transplant Center, Dr. Larry Munch of Methodist Urology and Dr. Larry Stevens perform approximately 50 living-related kidney donor procedures per year. We are honored to be part of this exciting program which helps patients recover full function off of renal dialysis.
